AFPA create new Zones

The AFPA National Council has agreed to the establishment of two new AFPA zones in order to better service the needs of an expanding membership. Placing members into zones based on their work role allows the AFPA to quickly identify and resolve systematic issues as well as represent the professional and industrial needs of a diverse organisation.

International Deployment Group Zone

The International Deployment Group Zone (IDG) includes all AFP employees that are either;

- 1) Deployed to the IDG under a 40H(2) Commissioners determination, or
- 2) have a role or posting assigned domestically to the International Deployment Group such as IDG Planning and Development; Missions and Operations; etc.
