



AFPA Bulletin: PSO Survey Preliminary Results to Commissioner 24 July 2008

AFP COMMISSIONER BRIEFED ON PRELIMINARY RESULTS OF AFPA PSO SURVEY

On Monday 21 July 2008 the AFPA National President Jon Hunt-Sharman and AFPA CEO Jim Torr met with AFP Commissioner Keelty to discuss a number of ongoing issues. The National President took the opportunity to brief the AFP Commissioner on the preliminary results of the PSO member survey.

A summary, with graphics, was provided to the AFP Commissioner for his consideration. The preliminary results were discussed and it was agreed that the AFPA would conduct further analysis of the data and provide a detailed breakdown of identifiable trends.

The AFP Commissioner has given an undertaking to forward the final AFPA report to the National Manager Aviation, Mandy Newton and National Manager Protection, Mark Ney so that further discussions can take place between the AFPA and the portfolio managers.

The results at this point give an overall picture of PSO's concerns, and we are in the process of breaking down the results into Aviation and Protection, and then by State, as it has become obvious that concerns differ between portfolios and regions.

Some of the outstanding results were over 88% see value in additional powers to carry out or clarify roles, over 80% want to develop their career path in the AFP, and more than two thirds are unsure of the future.

The AFP commissioner showed a genuine interest in the results of the AFPA survey, which has a sound statistical basis, due to the large number of responses from our members.

The AFPA would like to thank all AFPA members within Aviation CTFR and Uniform Protection for taking the time to complete this important survey. Once the data is fully analysed, the report will be accessible on our AFPA Website within the members Zone. Thank you for helping us help you.
