The bistro is open from Monday to Saturday serving lunch from 12pm - 2pm and dinner from 6pm - 9pm.

For the above reasons, the AFPA National Office has negotiated a special deal for all AFPA members. AFPA members are now automatically financial members of the RUC. You only have to show your AFPA membership card to have access to the RUC, discounted meals, coffee, bar area and other facilities.

These deals include the following:

- \$2 off RUC Classic meals at lunchtime;
- \$9.90 Members Meals from Monday to Friday evenings and regular discounts and specials on alcoholic beverages; and
- AFPA member specials.

The RUC will be a convenient meeting place for AFP Headquarters employees and Barton College employees, interstate trainees and attendees.
