# MEMBER UPDATE

## AFPA EA Update – Approval of AFP Enterprise Agreement 9 February 2018

Dear members,

As you are aware, the new Enterprise Agreement is currently with the Fair Work Commission (FWC) awaiting approval. Previous advice received from FWC indicated this approval process could take up to 12 weeks to complete. We understand this delay was as a result of more than 20 other employer organisations submitting agreements for approval prior to Christmas.

In response to these potential delays, the AFPA wrote to the Home Affairs Minister, Peter Dutton, seeking his intervention with a view to expediting the approval process. We also wrote to FWC, seeking the assistance of the Commission to have them expedite the approval. A copy of our letter to FWC is attached.

I am pleased to advise FWC has today responded to our correspondence and confirmed the approval process for the new Agreement will commence next week. Whilst I cannot pre-empt how long this approval will take, the fact the process is beginning is welcome news.

We will keep you updated as this process continues.
