AFPA Industrial Dispatch No:31 Clarifications 9 July 2018

Excessive annual leave and MRDs

In our attempt to clarify MRDs and annual leave we may have unintentionally confused some members.

To reiterate, any pre-booked leave will be deducted from your total annual leave balance.

As an example, if you currently have 300 hours of annual leave and pre-booked 72 hours of leave, then the 72 hours of pre-booked leave will be reduced from the 300 hours and bring your balance down to 228 hours.

Performance Development Agreements (PDAs)

Unfortunately, the advice we received from the AFP was out of date. We understand MPS has removed the former requirement to have a new PDA in place in order to receive the new payrise backdated to 24 May 2018.

We are advised that if you had a PDA in place and deemed 'fulfilled or ' for the previous PDA cycle, then you will be back-paid to 24 May 2018.

The AFP advises that members who have not satisfied this requirement, particularly members on maternity leave or extended leave, are encouraged to contact the Performance and Culture team (performanculture@afp.gov.au) about your particular circumstance.
