FACT SHEET

PROTECTED INDUSTRIAL ACTION

WRITING SLOGANS ON AFP **VEHICLES**

Is this action lawful?

Yes. The writing of official AFPA slogans on AFP marked and overt vehicles is deemed lawful protected industrial action (PIA).

What can I write on vehicles?

You can only write slogans authorised by the AFPA. Any other slogan may lead to unprotected industrial action.

Please only use chalk pens provided by the AFPA as they have been tested and the writing is non-permanent and will wipe off with water.

What do I do if directed to remove writing?

You are allowed to undertake PIA. Inform the person directing you that this action is PIA and allowed under the Fair Work Commission Order and Fair Work Act.

Record your interaction and notify your local Convenor or Delegate. Please also submit an 'AFPA Industrial Action Incident Report Form'. The form can be found via the QR code on this page.

Can I take photographs of the vehicle?

100% YES. We strongly encourage you to take photos and send them to the AFPA via eaafpa@afpa.org.au.

Photos will be used on official AFPA social media channels and provided to journalists to increase media exposure.

Where can I take photographs

Be creative and take photos in public places with nice and interesting backdrops. Just remember, don't place yourself or the community to danger while doing so.

Do I have to time record writing on vehicles?

Yes, even if writing the slogan takes 15 seconds, you are required to time record this activity. Members must promptly and accurately record their PIA in the appropriate time recording system.
